ENTRIES CLOSE

Make checks payable to GO DOGS (returned check charge is \$25). All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entries without the AKC agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4) Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.

**NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS
NEW AKC AGILITY JUMP HEIGHT POLICY**

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. **PLEASE BE SURE TO USE THE NEW ENTRY FORM!!**

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each titling class: Novice A & B, Open and Excellent A & B, Standard, JWW, and F.A.S.T., Regular and Preferred. Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class. A Rosette will be offered to all dogs finishing an agility title at these shows. Competitors earning a qualifying score in both Excellent B Std & Excellent B JWW (Double Q) will receive a rosette. Competitors earning a MACH will receive a commemorative rosette.

CHECK IN AND WALK THROUGH

FRIDAY Check-in will begin at 2 p.m. Walk through and Judge's briefing will be at 2:30 p.m. Judging begins promptly at 3 p.m.

RUNNING ORDER AS FOLLOWS: 4", 8", 12", 16", 20", 24" & 26" dogs.

CLASS ORDER AS FOLLOWS: Excellent Standard (Regular & Preferred), Excellent JWW (Regular & Preferred) and Excellent F.A.S.T. (Regular & Preferred).

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY FAST and Excellent check in time will begin at 7:15 a.m. Walk through and Judge's briefing will be at 7:30 a.m.

Judging begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. both days with the F.A.S.T. classes, followed by Excellent classes. Open and Novice Check In for Saturday and Sunday will begin at 9:30 a.m.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. There will be NO contact obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs at these trials.

REFUNDS

GO DOGS will refund the entry fees minus \$5 per run for any bitch in season or injured animal, with a veterinarian certificate. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.

SPECIAL NOTES:

VERBAL AND/OR PHYSICAL ABUSE OF ANY ANIMAL WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!

VENDORS BY PERMISSION ONLY. No unauthorized vendors will be allowed on the trial site. Contact the trial chairman for vending information.

RVs which take up more than one regular parking spot must park behind Bone Jour Day Care building in the lot on the south side of the building. NO EXCEPTIONS!

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These trials will be held outdoors on grass. Please bring shade tents, chairs, crates, and water for your dogs and clean up tools.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. GO DOGS reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Entry fees less \$5 administrative fee per run will be refunded for bitches coming in season after closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
